History of International Baccalaureate organization (IB)

- IB – an international non-governmental organization which has a consultative status in UNESCO and Europe Council.
- IB program was designed in 20-60 of the XX century as a universal course for more capable students which provides preparation for universities of all countries of the world.

- In 1968 – International Baccalaureate was established.
- On May 1 2018 IB united over 1.900,000 students from 5241 schools in 171 countries of the world.
- IB diploma is recognized by 3520 universities in 74 countries of the world, including such universities as Oxford, Yale, Cambridge, Harvard, Sorbonne, London School of Economics and etc.
- Central head-quarters are in Hague, Holland. Examination and program-methodological centre - Cardiff, Great Britain.

International Baccalaureate in Russia

- Since 1996.
- At present in Russia 48 schools are authorized, 32 of them are state and 16 are non-state in Russia.

IB schools in different countries of the world offer this program because...

- ... IB program presents huge academic opportunities to students;
- ... IB program corresponds to most strict academic standards;
- ... administrations of the best universities trust to DP IB;

- ... IB diploma is recognized in most countries of the world.

IB offers three educational programs:

Primary Years Programme (PYP) - program for Primary School is designed for children from 3 to 12 y.o.

Middle Years Programme (MYP) – program for middle school is designed for children from 11 to 16 y.o.

Diploma Programme (DP) – program of high school is designed for children from 16 to 18 y.o.

IB PYP

Primary schools in Russia teach programs of this country, adapted for IB standards. IN the core of the program there are a child's interests where a child learns through a deep inquiry on his own and carries a responsibility for the education.

In the program **6 transdisciplinary themes are included:**

- Who we are
- Where we are in place and time
- How the world works
- How we organize ourselves
- How we express ourselves
- Sharing the planet
